Parish of St. Andrews

- **1.4** Rev Judie moved and Bev Higgins seconded the approval of the Agenda as circulated. Carried.
- **1.5** Bev Higgins moved and Anne Fraser seconded the approval of the minutes as circulated. Carried.

Outstanding or New Business

- **8.1** <u>St. Andrew's Children's Shopping Day</u> Rick Morash read a letter from Brenda in regards to council members shopping ahead of opening time and purchasing gifts that were meant for the children of the community. It was agreed that we will not sell anything before the doors open on Saturday morning. Set up will take place on Thursday evening, December 12th at 7 pm.
- **8.2** <u>Date of AGM</u> The AGM will be held on February 9^{th} with all reports due by January 11^{th} .
- **8.3** <u>Nominating Committee</u> They have one name for a member-at-large but are still looking for people.
- **8.4** <u>Offering from Retirement Service</u> The offering from Rev Mike's retirement service went to the church.
- **8.5** <u>Suggestion Box</u> Two suggestions from the Suggestion Box in the vestibule: one was that we not sing every verse of the longer hymns; the other was that the mike on the podium be used when preaching as not everyone can hear.
- 8.6 <u>St. Luke's Proposal</u> A Warren Morash and Christopher Morash of HRM have offered to purchase St. Luke's property for \$175,000. Jean has spoken with Ian Angus about this offer. She asked about making a counter offer and Ian feels they would take a counter offer. If they cannot sub divide it they won't be willing to buy it. They also want an April closing date. They have offered a \$2500 down payment. Doug Gillett felt this wasn't much of a down payment. Doug agreed to take the purchase agreement and go over it to see if all is up and up. Ian said he would change the closing date from April to earlier in the year. It was felt we should take an offer of \$200,000 if we can get it.

Rev Judie moved we counter offer with \$225,000, giving the Wardens empowerment to accept nothing less than \$200,000, pending all diocesan approvals, without having to bring it back to council. Rick Morash seconded. This motion was carried.

Anne moved adjournment and we closed with the Grace at 8:15pm.
