# PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES

### June 19, 2014

The meeting opened with prayer at 7:00 pm.

#### Parish of St. Andrews

**1.4** The approval of the agenda was moved by Jinny and seconded by Bev H. Carried.

- **1.5** Erica moved and Rev Marilyn seconded the approval of the minutes as circulated. Carried.
- **1.6** <u>Ongoing Business</u> Hall Rental and Website will come under the Administration Report.

#### **Council Ministries Reports**

- 2.1 <u>Communications</u> A letter from Doug Gillett, in regards to the BCP only being used at the 9 am service, was read to council members. Rick Morash suggested that Doug's letter be taken to the minister and have feed back brought to the next council meeting.
- 2.2 <u>Rector's Report</u> No report.
- **2.3** <u>Warden's Report</u> The Wardens attended a Finance Committee meeting two days ago.

#### **Following Committees**

- **3.1** <u>Treasurer's Report</u> Bev Higgins moved and Jinny Giza seconded the adoption of the Treasurer's Report. Bev mentioned that the balance is down. She will provide an update for the bulletin for July. We will promote PAR in the bulletin for the summer. Motion was carried.
- **3.2** <u>Finance Report</u> A written report from the Finance Committee was presented to council. The Parish is financially challenged. Washroom improvements were discussed only. Remuneration for church volunteers was discussed. The only paid position is the organist. It was felt there should be a fixed rate for a fill-in organist.

Bev H. suggested \$75 for a service and \$25 for a practice. Bev H moved and Jinny seconded that all fill-in organists be given \$75 per service and \$25 per practice. Bev H. said that all fill-ins must accept this payment and it would be up to them if they want to give it back to the church. Carried.

Ideas were passed around about how to bring more money into the church via fundraising.

**3.3** <u>Ways and Means Report</u> – There was a problem with the Shop *and Support*. Rev Mark is looking into another company and this should be a go for the fall. Rick Morash said the Talent Show is a dead issue as very few came forward. Darlene Martell and Joanne Rector are no longer doing the Craft Show. Some suggestions were a Chocolate Party before Lent, a tea and invite the other churches. It was decided we would concentrate on the following fund raisers for the fall: *Turkey Supper, the Children's Christmas Sale, Monthly Lunches after church and a Lobster Dinner.* 

It was suggested that these four fund raisers be put in the bulletin and ask for some help with them.

**3.4** <u>Property Report and Cemetery</u> - Rick M showed us a design for a new upstairs washroom. A written report from Keith Fraser was presented.

# **Spiritual Development**

- **4.1** <u>Spiritual Development Report</u> The closing for the Sunday School was planned. Gordon and Marilyn will pick up hamburgers, hotdogs and drinks. There will be some games, potato chips, an egg race and gifts for the teachers.
- **4.2** <u>Sunday School Report</u> The Sunday School cleaned out there storage room and found some older books and Bibles that they no longer need. These will be placed at the back of the church for people to take.
- **4.3** <u>Choir Report</u> No report.
- **4.4** <u>Administration Committee Report</u> –.The Administration Committee met on April 30<sup>th</sup>. The committee is looking at producing leaflets for funerals. They have produced a new count sheet. The committee feels an email should be set up for the wardens to access the hall renal calendar.
