## Parish of St. Andrews

- **1.4** Rick Morash moved and Helen Clattenburg seconded that the agenda be accepted. Carried.
- **1.5** Rick Morash moved and Myril Wells seconded the approval of the minutes with amendments. All motions made at the previous meeting were accepted and the amount of \$350 for the steps which was over the budgeted amount was also accepted.

- 2.1 <u>Communications</u> None
- **2.2** <u>Rector's Report</u> The newsletter produced by Rev Mark only make it to half of the email addresses. The rest bounced back. Hard copies have been placed at the back of the church. **2.2** <u>Warden's Report</u> – They attended the Country Kitchen Party held on September 28<sup>th</sup>. \$285.10 was raised plus there was a \$40 donation which brought the total to \$325.10.

They met with Rev Judie and Rev Mark and worked on Open Church Sunday. A letter was read at both services on October 5<sup>th</sup> in regards to Rev. Judie's retirement.

- **3.1** <u>Treasurer's Report</u> There is now a deficit of -\$12,890.19. A \$10,000 GIC was cashed in. The bank also cashed in two \$5000 ones last month. Most of our expenses are fixed. Rev Mark suggested we might have to ask for a break from the allotment until we can get back on our feet. Bev Higgins moved and Rev Judie seconded the approval of this report. Carried.
- **3.2** <u>Finance Report</u> no report.
- **3.3** <u>Ways and Means Report</u> The Turkey Supper was discussed. Some felt turkeys should have been purchased when on sale for Thanksgiving. Wendy will look into getting the best price she can on turkeys. She will have the sign-up posters up this coming Sunday and Rev Mark promised to push it every Sunday.
- **3.4** <u>Property Report and Cemetery</u> There was no formal report. There will be a clean up and fixing of head stones this Saturday.

## Spiritual Development

- 4.1 Spiritual Development Report The Open Church Sunday was held. St. Luke's Service will be held on October 18<sup>th</sup>. There will be a Halloween Pot Luck and Dance held on October 24<sup>th</sup>. The Memorial Hymn Sing will be on November 3<sup>rd</sup>. On November 9<sup>th</sup> will we have a Remembrance Day Service. Rev Judie has invited Veterans, Scouts, Brownies, the MacDonald Legion, and Cadets. Tim Horton's will provide coffee and donuts for after the service. On November 27<sup>th</sup> an Advent Study called "The Lord is our Light" will begin at 2 pm. December 18<sup>th</sup> a "Blue Christmas" service will be held. The Memorial Angels will start on the first Sunday of Advent, November 30<sup>th</sup>, The Feast of St. Andrew.

We gave a \$50 donation towards turkeys for the Turkey Supper. We are collecting for the Mission to Seafarers again and will pack the shoeboxes on December  $6^{th}$  at 9 am in the church.

Our Christmas party will be held on December 5<sup>th</sup>. Special guests will be invited. It will be in the form of a pot luck and we will donate the money we would have spent on a gift for our Prayer Partner to a needy family. Our 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Tree Lighting and Carol Sing will be held on December 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm. We will purchase two more sets of lights. We will donate \$100 to the Marguerite Center in early December. We have given the church \$600 to honour our commitment. We will decorate the Church for Christmas after the service on December 21<sup>st</sup>.

- **8.3** <u>Safe-r-church</u> Rick M emailed each committee for a report on their activities. Bev H has had a police check done. The Sunday School Teachers have all completed their checks and these on in the safe. All clergy have their records at the Diocese.

The fee is \$50 to have these checks done. Linda will write a letter for Shawn Rideout. We need a new hall rental form. Rick will construct one.
