### **CEMETERY POLICY**

#### **Full Burial Lots**

The cost of conveyance of a full burial cemetery lots to known parishioners and their immediate families (children), is \$300 (three hundred dollars). Full burial lots may be conveyed to deceased extended family members of parishioners, if they have been baptized, for the amount of \$600 (six hundred dollars), subject to the availability of lots. The cost for digging a full burial lot is \$450 (four hundred and fifty dollars).

The size of each Full Burial Lot is 4ft. by 8ft. The area of a newly-assigned lot shall be staked out by the Property Committee who shall have a representative present during the opening and closing of the burial lot.

The grave is to be marked with a suitable headstone, or stone marker set into the ground, provided by the family within 12 months of the burial.

Arrangements for the opening of the grave must be made by the family in consultation with the Wardens. The family is responsible for the cost of opening and closing of the grave, and for the purchase and placement of a headstone or stone marker.

#### Columbarium Lots ( Cremations)

The cost of conveyance of Columbarium Lots to known parishioners and their immediate families (children), is \$200 ( two hundred dollars). Columbarium lots may be conveyed to deceased extended family members of parishioners, if they have been baptized, for the amount of \$400 (four hundred dollars), subject to availability. The cost for digging or subsequent opening of a Columbarium lot is \$250.

Parishioners will be sold the next available Columbarium lot(s) in numbered sequence.

The size of each Columbarium lot is 3 ft. square. Location of lot is as shown on the Lot Plan.

A maximum of two cremations per Columbarium lot is permitted.

Burials in the Columbarium shall be marked with a flat, rectangular stone marker centered within the lot, set flush with the ground, and be no larger than 12 inches x 24 inches. The stone marker is to be placed within 12 months of interment and is to be orientated so the inscription runs parallel to Highway 3 and can be read by a person facing the Highway. No permanent fixtures above the top surface of the marker stone are permitted. This is to facilitate lawn care of the columbarium. All costs associated with the stone marker are the responsibility of the family.

### **CEMETERY BY-LAWS**

for

## St. Andrew's Church in the Parish of Timberlea-Lakeside Nova Scotia

The following By-Laws will be enforced by St. Andrew's Cemetery Committee unless otherwise directed by the Parish Council.

- All burials in St. Andrew's Cemetery will be according to the rites of the Anglican Church of Canada.
- No lot owner shall change the grading of his/her lot and should such change be made, it will be restored to its original grade at the expense of the owner. Adhering to this By-Law, mounds will not be allowed over graves.
- 3. Borders, fences, railings, walls, cut stone and hedges in or around lots are not permitted as they hinder the on-going maintenance of the cemetery. Any such items which have been erected prior to the enactment of these By-Laws may be removed if the Cemetery Committee deems them a hindrance to the maintenance. In this case, the lot owner will be notified in writing and given ninety (90) days to make the necessary improvements to the lot.
- 4. Lot owners, or their family or legal representative if the owner is deceased, are responsible for the purchase and placement of headstones / markers. They are also required to keep their lots, stones, monuments, etc. on their lots in proper repair at their own expense and to the satisfaction of the Cemetery Committee. The locations of the new headstone / markers on any lot to be staked out by the Cemetery Committee who shall have a representative present during placement.
- 5. No planting, pots or planters will be allowed on any lot as it interferes with the landscaping and general maintenance carried out by the Cemetery Committee. However, cut flowers and small potted plants that can be readily removed are permitted.
- 6. Lot owners are to clear all flowers and potted plants by no later than October 31 of each year and are to remove any plants or flowers before they become unsightly. In certain situations the Cemetery Committee will remove old flowers and potted plants from a particular lot to uphold the general appearance of the cemetery.
- 7. Artificial decorations are normally allowed only from November 1 to April 1 of the following year. However, this is at the discretion of the Cemetery Committee.
- 8. The Cemetery Committee assumes no responsibility for the damage or loss of any portable article that is left on a lot or grave site.
- Owners of existing vacant Full Burial lots may inter up to a maximum of 4 (four) cremations
- Owners of existing vacant Full Burial lots may request an exchange of their Full Burial lot for a Columbarium Lot at no additional cost and no moneys will be refunded.
